

Before applying the bandage:

- Call vet if regired
- 2. Have the horse safely restrained
- 3. Ensure the wound is thoroughly cleaned and dry
- 4. Have all your bandage materials ready

Materials you need:

- 1. Gloves
- 2. Appropriate size steri-pad (melolin)
- 3. Soffban (optional)
- 4. Appropriate size Cotton Wool gamgee
- 5. Vet wrap
- 6. Elastoplast





Step 1: Apply steri-pad with cream to wound with shiney side towards the horse



Step 2: Wrap soffban to secure steripad





Step 3: Apply cotton wool gamgee and wrap around, ideally covering the joint above and below the wound



Step 4: Apply vetwrap using firm pressure.
Ensure vetwrap is not touching skin



Step 5: Check area to make sure it is firm without it being too tight



Step 6: start applying
elastoplast
above Gamgee and vetwrap
to secure position



Step 7: Wrap Elastoplast around the bandage firmly



Step 8: Finish wrap with elastoplast on the skin without it being tight

Depending on location, make incision into bandage to allow horse to move comfortably
