

Before taking your horses temperature:

- 1. Have the horse safely restrained
- 2. Check the thermometre is working
- 3. Stand safely on the side of the horse

Materials you need:

- 1. Gloves
- 2. Thermometre
- 3. Halter and lead rope
- 4. Handler



Normal Ranges

An adult horse's normal temperature is:

37.2°C - 38.5°C

A foal's normal temperature is:

37.5°C - 38.8°C





Step 1: Catch the horse and have safely restrained



Step 2 : Lift tail and locate anus





Step 3 : Stand on the same side as the handler and at a safe distance



Step 4: Turn thermoetre on, place gently into the rectum and tilt towards the rectal wall for reading
